The Blue Flag and the bathing water quality.

This beach has obtained this year the Blue Flag and the Q of Quality.

It means that it complies with a group of criteria related to the bathing water quality, the beach cleaning, sanitary services, safety and also it signifies that the municipality offers information and develops environmental education activities.

In addition, it means that the bathing water quality is controlled regularly, analyzing certain types of bacteria at least every two weeks during the entire bathing season in two different points of the beach by the competent autonomous Government.

In the box above, you can check when the last water analysis was and how many bacteria were found. If it is detected a small number of bacteria, the water is very clean. - A big number of bacteria indicates that the water may be contaminated and may contain bacteria from the sewage-. The limit allowed is specified in the box above.
